

# Associated newspaper register

The associated newspaper register assists the ABA in monitoring compliance with the cross-media provisions of the Act.

Under the Act a person must not be in a position to exercise control of both a commercial television broadcasting licence and a commercial radio broadcasting licence which have the same licence area. Similarly, a person must not be in a position to exercise control of a commercial television broadcasting licence, or a commercial radio broadcasting licence, and a newspaper associated with the licence area of such a licence.

The associated newspaper register is updated bi-annually or as required.

The *Broadcasting Services Act 1992* defines the term Newspaper at s. 6:

Newspaper means a newspaper that is in the English language and is published on at least 4 days in each week, but does include a publication if less than 50% of its circulation is by way of sale.

Section 59(3) provides:

If the ABA is satisfied that at least 50% of the circulation of a newspaper is within the licence area of a commercial television broadcasting licence or a commercial radio broadcasting licence, the ABA is to enter the name of the newspaper in the Register in relation to that licence area.

## Large circulation newspaper register

Under s. 106 of the Act a person who is in a position to exercise control of a newspaper that is entered in the Large circulation newspaper register must not have company inter-

ests exceeding two per cent in, or be in a position to exercise control of, satellite subscription television broadcasting licence A. This provision ceases to have effect on 1 July 1997.
