

News Update

the 1996-97 financial year, with results from the survey being available in mid 1998. The ABS has consulted with agencies such as the ABA and has worked closely with organisations in the above mentioned fields regarding the detailed content and design of the survey. Information collected will provide a picture of the contribution the sector makes to the economy and will be a valuable resource for planning, policy formulation and decision-making.

The surveys seek a breakdown of gross income, expenses, assets, liabilities, capital expenditure and disposal of assets which are all readily available from annual reports and audited accounts. Additional questions on employment are also asked, along with some questions relating to specific items of interest within the various industries. As with all ABS surveys the information provided will remain strictly confidential to the ABS and will only be released in aggregate form.

Publications are due to be released progressively from April to July 1998, and will detail changes in the film and video production, film and video distribution, motion picture exhibition, radio services and television services industries since 1993-94.
