
News Update



Council (RSAC) in the USA, the ECO Forum in Germany, and Childnet International (with offices in the UK and the USA) to form an international working group to discuss a number of issues involving content rating. The World Wide Web Consortium which developed the PICS technology has recently joined the group.

Representatives of the group met recently in the UK to discuss aims and objectives, identify the principles and challenges for work in the area and consider the best strategy for progressing and funding the proposal.

The group's aims and objectives include the development of a labelling scheme for the Internet which accommodates a range of crosscultural concerns and is appropriate for international use. The group has agreed that the scheme be voluntary, based on self-labelling, free for users and easy for both users and content providers to use. It also agreed that an international labelling scheme should describe rather than evaluate Internet content so users can apply their own standards and values in choosing sites they wish to block at their own computer.

The group is currently developing an action plan and considering an appropriate international consultation process. The ABA will work closely with Childnet International on this aspect of the group's work.
