Vice chairman: UNESCO's communications commission 5

Mr Gareth Grainger, ABA Deputy Chairman, has been unanimously elected Vice Chairman of Commission 5 on Communications, Information and Informatics at UNESCO's 30th General Conference in Paris.

Mr Grainger is also Chairman of the

Communications Network of the Australian National Commission for UNESCO.

While at the General Conference, Mr Grainger made an intervention proposing strategies for UNESCO's involvement in the communications and information sectors in the coming decade. In making the intervention, Mr Grainger drew on the conclusions of a number of forums concerning regulatory policy in the communications and information sectors.
