



The ABA has decided to make licences available for five new radio services in Gosford: one new commercial radio service, three new community radio services and one open narrowcasting service and reserved channels for two new national radio services.

The ABA has decided to make licences available for five new radio services in Gosford.

The ABA's decisions are contained in its final licence area plan for radio in Gosford.

'The ABA has taken into account the views of all who made submissions before deciding on the most beneficial mix of new services to made available in the Gosford region,' said Professor Flint.

'There are special issues for regional markets which abut metropolitan areas. The ABA has given careful consideration to these in planning Gosford,' he said.

'With a very limited number of radio channels, the high demand from aspirant broadcasters and technical restraints on a majority of channels. decisions on the best use of these channels was always going to be difficult.'

'Ultimately, the ABA has been guided by the objects of the Broadcasting Services Act 1992, particularly that of promoting the availability to audiences of a diverse range of radio and television services offering entertainment. education and information.'
