## New community radio licences for northern NSW

The ABA has invited applications for four new community radio licences in the northern NSW radio market. There is one licence for each of the Ballina, Casino, Coraki and Nimbin areas.

'Allocation of new community radio licences has begun in the northern NSW market as a result of the completion of the ABA's public planning process in this area,' said Professor David Flint, ABA Chairman. 'The planning process identified a demand for new community services operated by people living in the Ballina, Casino, Coraki and Nimbin communities.'

Free-to-air community radio licences are allocated on the basis of merit.
