



Spectrum Tune-Up 2009

ACMA hosted Spectrum Tune-Up 2009 at its Canberra offices in Belconnen on Tuesday 24 February 2009.

The one-day seminar was an opportunity for delegates to hear the latest developments in major ACMA spectrum projects and to exchange ideas and feedback with radiocommunications professionals from across industry and government.

In the morning session of Spectrum Tune-Up, ACMA staff discussed matters of spectrum licensing, including an update on 2.3 GHz allocation and its marketing plan and an overview of spectrum trading.

The afternoon session focused on microwave service, with news about 4.9 GHz wireless spectrum for emergency services, and exciting developments in the high microwave bands. The day concluded with a mini panel session on microwave and 4.9 GHz matters.

Spectrum Tune-Up attracted over 40 non-ACMA delegates and was well received by the group.

Inputs to Industry Division General Manager Giles Tanner made special mention of the upcoming RadComms09 conference in his closing remarks. Spectrum Tune-Up delegates were encouraged to register for RadComms09.

ACMA is planning a third Spectrum Tune-Up for another capital city later in 2009.
