

SUBMISSION OF MANUSCRIPTS

In preparing articles for submission authors should be guided by the following points:

1. Submissions may be made via email to: <sarah.vujcic@ adelaide.edu.au>. A hard copy should be posted to: The Editor, Adelaide Law Review, School of Law, The University of Adelaide, SA 5005.
2. Authors are expected to check the accuracy of all references in the manuscript before submission. It is not always possible to submit proofs for correction.
3. Biographical details should be starred (*) and precede the footnotes. They should include the author's academic qualifications and current employment.
4. The journal has adopted the *Australian Guide to Legal Citation*, published by the Melbourne University Law Review Association Inc. A PDF version can be found on their website: <<http://mulr.law.unimelb.edu.au/files/aglcdl.pdf>>
5. An abstract of between 150 and 200 words should also be included with the submitted article.
6. If the submitted article is accepted by the *Adelaide Law Review*, it will be published in both the traditional Law Review and electronically.
