SUBMISSION OF MANUSCRIPTS

In preparing articles for submission authors should be guided by the following points:

- 1. Submissions must be made via email <panita.hirunboot@adelaide.edu.au> or ExpressO <http://law.bepress.com/expresso/>.
- 2. Authors are expected to check the accuracy of all references in the manuscript before submission. It is not always possible to submit proofs for correction.
- 3. Biographical details should be starred (*) and precede the footnotes. They should include the author's academic qualifications and current employment.
- 4. The journal has adopted the *Australian Guide to Legal Citation* (AGLC3), published by the Melbourne University Law Review Association Inc ">http://mu
- 5. An abstract of between 150 and 200 words should also be included with the submitted contribution (excluding book reviews).
- 6. If the contribution is accepted by the *Adelaide Law Review*, it will be published in both the traditional Law Review and electronically.
