

SUBMISSION OF MANUSCRIPTS

In preparing articles for submission authors should be guided by the following points:

1. Submissions must be made via email <panita.hirunboot@adelaide.edu.au> or ExpressO <<http://law.bepress.com/expresso/>>.
2. Authors are expected to check the accuracy of all references in the manuscript before submission. It is not always possible to submit proofs for correction.
3. Biographical details should be starred (*) and precede the footnotes. They should include the author's academic qualifications and current employment.
4. The journal has adopted the *Australian Guide to Legal Citation* (AGLC3), published by the Melbourne University Law Review Association Inc <<http://mulr.law.unimelb.edu.au/go/aglc>>.
5. An abstract of between 150 and 200 words should also be included with the submitted contribution (excluding book reviews).
6. If the contribution is accepted by the *Adelaide Law Review*, it will be published in both the traditional Law Review and electronically.
