
## C hanges at the DPP

## Full Court Sittings for 1998

Pursuant to sections 12 and 15 of the Federal Court of Australia Act 1976, notice is hereby given that sittings of a Full Court of the Federal Court of Australia during 1998 will be held at the places and will be conducted during the dates indicated below:

- No sittings will be held unless there is a substantial amount of business.
- An urgent matter may be transferred to a place of sitting other than that in which the matter was filed.
- If the circumstances require it a Full Court may sit in capital cities to deal with matters on dates other than those listed.

The Registrar, Mr Warwick Soden advises that this roster reflects a change in Full Court Sittings and notes the following by way of explanation:

Unlike previous years when Full Court Sittings commenced in Sydney in February and were held consecutively around Australia, in a number of cities more than once, the Full Court Sittings for 1998 and future years will be held in a Full Court Sitting period which will occur three times a year. Although the Full Court Sittings will be held in each of the capital cities during that four-week period, it will not follow that, for example, Sydney Full Court Sittings will be held at the same time as Melbourne Full Court Sittings. As well, it may be that the Brisbane Full Court Sittings will be held in the first two weeks of the four week period which would be at the same time as the first two weeks of the Sydney Full Court Sittings
