A brand owner under the Used Packaging Materials EPP must prepare, maintain and implement an action plan and comply with the plan. Furthermore, a brand owner must, within three months of the end of a financial year, record specified information in relation to each type of material used as consumer packaging by them during that financial year.

The provisions do not apply to small businesses that do not contribute significantly to the waste stream. Further, the provisions do not apply to containers covered by container deposit legislation under the Environment Protection Act as recycling and reuse matters are already dealt with for those containers covered by the legislation.
