n 2 and 3 March 1998, APLA convened a specialist conference on Birth Trauma Litigation, in conjunction with the Birth Trauma Litigation Group of the American Trial Lawyers Association. APLA believes the conference was a "first" for Australian lawyers, addressing both medical and legal issues in depth.

Les Weisbrod of Morgan & Weisbrod (Dallas, Texas) and Bill Madden of Blessington Judd (Sydney, NSW) chaired the event, with twelve legal and medical speakers from Australia and the USA. The medical specialists covered obstetrics, neonatology, neuroradiology, placental pathology and blood gas analysis. Two case studies were utilised to demonstrate the medical topics. Legal speakers addressed causation, common defences and damages along with life expectancy arguments.
