FIRE IN FORD COURIER CREW CAB

I act for plaintiffs who sustained injuries as a result of a fire developing in the engine of a Ford Courier Crew Cab vehicle that was manufactured in Japan in or about October 1994. There was an incident of a fire developing in the engine and then repair work carried out to the vehicle. A second fire caused the plaintiffs' injuries. It is alleged that the fires were caused by coolant entering the oil sump that caused:

- 1. The operating temperature of the engine to increase;
- 2. The boiling of sump fluids;
- 3. Increased pressure within the sump and sump crank case; and then
- Oil or oil vapour to escape and discharge via the dipstick or the dipstick opening onto the hot exhaust manifold where ignition occurred.

I would appreciate hearing from any members who have or have had a similar case against the manufacturer or repairer of this type of vehicle - particularly in relation to expert evidence.
