telp for parents of LD children

The association for Children With Learning Disabilities (ACLD) has just published a book, My Child Can Learn aimed at helping parents whose children have learning probems and are struggling to cope at school. This book has grown out of ACLD's experience with the queries and concerns of parents and professional workers who are closely issociated with children with learning probems. It contains answers to common quesions and a guide to services available in V.S.W. It is intended to be a resource book in which useful information can be found simoly by turning to the relevant section. A quick reading of the whole provides a helpful overview of problems and possible solutions.

My Child Can Learn advises parents on early recognition; the where, when, how and who of successful assessment (i.e. testing); and the various intervention possibilities — social, recreational, medical, educational and vocational. Most importantly, it advises parents on the spread of resources (state wide) and how to make the most of what ittle is available.

Present research puts the number of children in N.S.W. with learning problems at 115,000 and the number of mildly intellectually handicapped at 22,400. These are staggering figures when you look at 13.54% of the total school population as being either mildly intellectually handicapped or having learning problems.
