## **ASCIS** software reviews

Software evaluations for educational use, are now available on the ASCIS database. The National Software Co-ordination Unit (NSCU) has brought together reviews of software from education authorities all over Australia. Access to these can be made by subscribing to the microfiche service (\$20 per year) or by dialing ASCIS online (\$15 per hour).

These records will help teachers to identify software which is suitable for their respective hardware, specific curriculum areas and student level, as well as information on publisher, price and policies on issues such as site licence, back up and replacement disks.

ASCIS now contains over 340,000 bibliographic records for materials found in school library collections. Other services are being added to make this database more useful including information on curriculum documents, reviews of educational resources and information on resource collections for specific subject areas.
