# Fees 2002–03

he Board of Directors has determined the fees for the 2002-03 membership year, which commences on 1 July 2002. Fees are revised annually, usually in accordance with the movements in Average Weekly Earnings (AWE) and Consumer Price Index (CPI).

### Membership fee

The Board of Directors continues the commitment to keep membership fees at a comparative level of those in 1999, prior to the introduction of the GST, which was absorbed. Personal membership fees will increase by the 4.4 per cent annual movement in AWE. Acknowledging requests made by Library Technician members, the cut-off point between Full fee and Reduced fee will be lifted from \$25 000 to \$30 000 to encourage library and information professionals on lower salaries to become and remain personal members. The reduced fee applies also to recent graduates for up to two years after graduation.

Institutional membership fees will increase by 3.1 per cent, equivalent to the annual movement in CPI. Institutional members will receive added benefits, as outlined below.

The Board has decided to acknowledge higher paying institutions by offering institutional members in grades C4, C5 and C6 the option to, from 1 July 2002:

- receive up to three free subscriptions to inCite and twentyfive per cent discount on any further copies (to the same mailing address);
- receive up to two free subscriptions to the Australian Library Journal and over twenty-five per cent discount on any further copies (to the same mailing address); and
- receive member discount for up to three staff attending ALIA conferences, seminars and workshops.

Institutional members may now nominate a staff member to represent the institution in ALIA groups and become an office bearer. A written nomination signed by the institution's appointed representative is required.

The ALIA Handbook will be published in electronic format only and will be available on ALIAnet. The ALIA Handbook is retrospective in content, providing the official record at the end of the previous calendar year.

#### Fee for recognition of overseas qualifications

The assessment fee for recognition of overseas qualifications has been unchanged for a number of years. From 1 April 2002, the fee will be \$110 (incl GST) and will include the issuing of a certificate to successful applicants. It is not refundable.
