

he scenes of destruction caused by Cyclone Pam on the islands of Vanuatu will not easily be forgotten. Although the National Library and Archives survived untouched, the school libraries across the islands weren't so lucky.

As Chief Librarian and Archivist June Bela Naviti wrote to ALIA:

'We would like to see these libraries stand up again. We are building a collection of books to send to some school libraries which have been severely damaged by Cyclone Pam.

We are collecting children's books, reference books like encyclopedias, English dictionaries, French dictionaries, non-fiction books and school readers.'

ALIA contacted June, and the FAIR advocacy campaign has raised funds for the purchase of suitable books for Vanuatu's school libraries.

We're now talking with publishers about the book purchase and how best to get the books to Vanuatu. We'll keep you posted!
