

THE TERRITORY FOR THE SEAT OF GOVERNMENT.

No. 11 of 1933.

AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Dogs Registration Ordinance 1926.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909* and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1931*, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Dogs Registration Ordinance 1933*. Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Dogs Registration Ordinance 1926* is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Dogs Registration Ordinance 1926-1933*.

2. Section five of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting the word “Commission” and inserting in its stead the word “Minister”. Appointment of registrar.

3. Section seven of the Principal Ordinance is amended— Registration of dogs.

(a) by omitting from sub-section (3.) the words “offices of the Commission at Canberra” and inserting in their stead the words “office of the Registrar”; and

(b) by omitting from sub-section (3.) the word “Commission” (second occurring) and inserting in its stead the word “Registrar”.

4. Section nine of the Principal Ordinance is amended— Fees on registration.

(a) by omitting the word “Commission” and inserting in its stead the word “Registrar”;

(b) by omitting the word “Ten” and inserting in its stead the word “Five”; and

(c) by omitting the second proviso.

5. The Schedule to the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting the words “Federal Capital Commission” (wherever occurring). Schedule.
