AUSTRALIAN CAPITAL TERRITORY.

No. 2 of 1941.

AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Deserted Wives and Children Act, 1901, of the State of New South Wales, in its application to the Territory, as amended by the Deserted Wives and Children Ordinance 1932.*

B E it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909-1938 and the Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1940, as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Deserted Wives and short title. Children Ordinance 1941.

2. Section eleven of the Deserted Wives and Children Act, Disobedience 1901, of the State of New South Wales, in its application to the of order may be Territory, as amended by the Deserted Wives and Children Ordinance 1932, is amended by omitting from sub-section (1.) the words "four shillings" (wherever occurring), and inserting in their stead the words "ten shillings".
