An Ordinance to amend the Alsatian Dogs Ordinance 1934 as amended

[Assented to 6 September, 1972]

B^E it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Northern Territory of Australia as follows: Territory of Australia as follows:

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Alsatian Dogs Short title and citation Ordinance 1972.

2. The Alsatian Dogs Ordinance 1934 as amended is in Principal Ordinance this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

3. Section 7 of the Principal Ordinance is amended—

Exemption

- (a) by omitting paragraph (b) and inserting in its stead the following paragraph:—
 - "(b) the dog is kept in the City of Darwin, the Town of Alice Springs or the Town of Tennant Creek:":
- (b) by omitting from paragraph (c) the words "the association known as the German Shepherd Dog Club of the Northern Territory" and inserting in their stead the words "with a prescribed companion dog club";
- (c) by omitting from paragraph (d) the words "the German Shepherd Dog Club of the Northern Territory" and inserting in their stead the words "a prescribed companion dog club"; and
- (d) by adding at the end thereof the following subsection:-
 - "(2.) In this section, 'prescribed companion dog club' means the association known as the German Shepherd Dog Club of the Northern Territory or the Darwin Obedience Dog Club Incorporated, and includes a club or association that is affiliated with the association known as

the North Australian Canine Association and is declared by the Administrator in Council, by notice published in the *Gazette*, to be a prescribed companion dog club for the purposes of this section."
