

# ALSATIAN DOGS ORDINANCE 1972

## An Ordinance to amend the *Alsatian Dogs Ordinance* 1934 as amended

[Assented to 6 September, 1972]

**B**E it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Northern Territory of Australia as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Alsatian Dogs Ordinance* 1972. Short title and citation

2. The *Alsatian Dogs Ordinance* 1934 as amended is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance. Principal Ordinance

3. Section 7 of the Principal Ordinance is amended— Exemption

(a) by omitting paragraph (b) and inserting in its stead the following paragraph:—

“(b) the dog is kept in the City of Darwin, the Town of Alice Springs or the Town of Tennant Creek;”;

(b) by omitting from paragraph (c) the words “the association known as the German Shepherd Dog Club of the Northern Territory” and inserting in their stead the words “with a prescribed companion dog club”;

(c) by omitting from paragraph (d) the words “the German Shepherd Dog Club of the Northern Territory” and inserting in their stead the words “a prescribed companion dog club”; and

(d) by adding at the end thereof the following subsection:—

“(2.) In this section, ‘prescribed companion dog club’ means the association known as the German Shepherd Dog Club of the Northern Territory or the Darwin Obedience Dog Club Incorporated, and includes a club or association that is affiliated with the association known as

the North Australian Canine Association and is declared by the Administrator in Council, by notice published in the *Gazette*, to be a prescribed companion dog club for the purposes of this section.”.
