## An Ordinance to amend the Auctioneers Ordinance 1935-1955.

[Assented to 3rd February, 1961.]

 $\mathbf{B}^{\mathrm{E}}$  it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Northern Territory of Australia, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Northern Territory (Administration) Act 1910-1959. as follows:----

1.--(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the Auctioneers short title and citation. Ordinance 1960.

(2.) The Auctioneers Ordinance 1935-1955 as amended by this Ordinance may be cited as the Auctioneers Ordinance 1935-1960.

2 Section fourteen of the Auctioneers Ordinance 1935- Record to 1955 is amended by omitting the words "Superintendent of Police" (wherever occurring) and inserting in their stead the words "Deputy Commissioner of Police".

3. Section sixteen of the Principal Ordinance is amended—

- (a) by deleting the words ", after sunset or before sunrise on any day throughout the year, except in such cases as the Administrator specially approves,";
- (b) by adding after the word "property" the following:—

"(a) on any Sunday, Good Friday or Christmas Day, or

"(b) on any other day between the hours of eleven o'clock after noon and eight o'clock before noon.".
