

# AUCTIONEERS ORDINANCE 1960.

29

## No. 10 of 1961.

An Ordinance to amend the *Auctioneers Ordinance* 1935-1955.

[Assented to 3rd February, 1961.]

**B**E it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Northern Territory of Australia, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Northern Territory (Administration) Act* 1910-1959, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Auctioneers Ordinance* 1960. Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Auctioneers Ordinance* 1935-1955 as amended by this Ordinance may be cited as the *Auctioneers Ordinance* 1935-1960.

2 Section fourteen of the *Auctioneers Ordinance* 1935-1955 is amended by omitting the words "Superintendent of Police" (wherever occurring) and inserting in their stead the words "Deputy Commissioner of Police". Record to be kept.

3. Section sixteen of the Principal Ordinance is amended—

(a) by deleting the words " , after sunset or before sunrise on any day throughout the year, except in such cases as the Administrator specially approves,";

(b) by adding after the word "property" the following:—

" (a) on any Sunday, Good Friday or Christmas Day, or

" (b) on any other day between the hours of eleven o'clock after noon and eight o'clock before noon."
