An Ordinance to amend the Alice Springs Administration Ordinance 1937–1956.

[Assented to 31st July, 1963.]

B^E it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Northern Territory of Australia, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Northern Territory (Administration) Act 1910-1962, as follows:—

Short title and citation.

- 1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the Alice Springs Administration Ordinance 1963.
- (2.) The Alice Springs Administration Ordinance 1937-1956 is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.
- (3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the Alice Springs Administration Ordinance 1937-1963.

Regulations.

- 2. Section twenty-four of the Principal Ordinance is amended by inserting after paragraph (e) the following paragraph:—
 - "(f) the prohibition, except in accordance with the permission in writing of the Administrator, or the regulation, of—
 - (i) the erection of lamps, signs, devices and advertisements or of any of them; and
 - (ii) the erection, within twelve feet of a public road or place, of hoardings and other erections used for advertising purposes or of either them."
