

# ALICE SPRINGS ADMINISTRATION ORDINANCE 1963.

No. 55 of 1963.

An Ordinance to amend the *Alice Springs  
Administration Ordinance 1937-1956.*

[Assented to 31st July, 1963.]

**B**E it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Northern Territory of Australia, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Northern Territory (Administration) Act 1910-1962*, as follows:—

Short title and  
citation.

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Alice Springs Administration Ordinance 1963.*

(2.) The *Alice Springs Administration Ordinance 1937-1956* is in this Ordinance referred to as the *Principal Ordinance.*

(3.) The *Principal Ordinance*, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Alice Springs Administration Ordinance 1937-1963.*

Regulations.

2. Section twenty-four of the *Principal Ordinance* is amended by inserting after paragraph (e) the following paragraph:—

“(f) the prohibition, except in accordance with the permission in writing of the Administrator, or the regulation, of—

- (i) the erection of lamps, signs, devices and advertisements or of any of them; and
- (ii) the erection, within twelve feet of a public road or place, of hoardings and other erections used for advertising purposes or of either of them.”
