

ALICE SPRINGS HOSPITAL ADVISORY BOARD ORDINANCE (NO. 2) 1962.

No. 15 of 1963.

An Ordinance to amend the *Alice Springs Hospital
Advisory Board Ordinance 1962.*

[Assented to 13th February, 1963.]

BE it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Northern Territory of Australia, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Northern Territory (Administration) Act 1910-1961*, as follows:—

Short title
and citation.

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Alice Springs Hospital Advisory Board Ordinance (No. 2) 1962.*

(2.) The *Alice Springs Hospital Advisory Board Ordinance 1962* is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Alice Springs Hospital Advisory Board Ordinances 1962.*

Constitution
of the Board.

2. Section four of the Principal Ordinance is amended—

(a) by inserting in paragraph (a) of sub-section (1.), before the words “medical practitioner” the word “private”; and

(b) by adding at the end of paragraph (a) the following words:—“or if there is no such private medical practitioner, any other medical practitioner so registered and residing”.

Appointment
of members.

3. Section five of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting from sub-section (7.) the word “six” and inserting in its stead the word “four”.
