

ALICE SPRINGS TOWN MANAGEMENT ORDINANCE 1967

No. 2 of 1967

An Ordinance to amend the *Alice Springs Town Management Ordinance 1961-1965*

[Assented to 13 March, 1967]

BE it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Northern Territory of Australia, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Northern Territory (Administration) Act 1910-1965*, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Alice Springs Town Management Ordinance 1967*.

Short title
and citation

(2.) The *Alice Springs Town Management Ordinance 1961-1965* is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Alice Springs Town Management Ordinance 1961-1967*.

2. Section 4 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting sub-section (3.).

Establishment
of Board

3. After section 4 of the Principal Ordinance the following section is inserted:—

“4AA.—(1.) For the purposes of the first meeting of the Board after a general election, the Administrator shall appoint a member of the Board to be the Chairman and another member of the Board to be the Deputy Chairman and the Chairman and Deputy Chairman so appointed shall hold office until a Chairman and a Deputy Chairman respectively are elected by the Board.

“(2.) At its first meeting after a general election, the Board shall elect a member of the Board to be the Chairman and another member of the Board to be the Deputy Chairman.

“(3.) The office of Deputy Chairman becomes vacant if its holder is elected to be the Chairman and the office of Chairman or Deputy Chairman becomes vacant if its holder—

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- (a) ceases to be a member of the Board;
- (b) resigns his office in writing addressed to the Board;
or
- (c) is removed from office by a resolution of the Board.

“(4.) When the office of Chairman or Deputy Chairman becomes vacant, the Board shall elect a Chairman or Deputy Chairman, as the case requires, from members of the Board.

“(5.) When the office of Chairman is vacant or when the Chairman is, because of absence or illness or for any other reason, unable to exercise his powers or perform his duties, the Deputy Chairman has and may exercise those powers and has and shall perform those duties.”

Transitional
provisions

4. The persons holding office as Chairman and Deputy Chairman respectively at the date of commencement of this Ordinance shall continue to hold office until a Chairman and a Deputy Chairman are elected by the Board and the Board shall, at its first meeting after the date of commencement of this Ordinance, elect a member of the Board to be the Chairman and another member of the Board to be the Deputy Chairman.
