## An Ordinance to amend The Criminal Law Consolidation Act and Ordinance 1876 to 1968

[Assented to 29 October, 1969]

B E it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Northern
Territory of Australia as fallows: Territory of Australia as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the Criminal Short title and citation Law Consolidation Ordinance 1969.

- (2.) The Criminal Law Consolidation Act and Ordinance 1876 to 1968 is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Statute.
- (3.) The Principal Statute as amended by this Ordinance may be cited as The Criminal Law Consolidation Act and Ordinance 1876 to 1969.
- 2. After the words "Injuries to Cattle, etc." occurring immediately before section 117 of the Principal Statute the following section is inserted:—

"116A. In each of the next three succeeding sections "cattle" Definition of "cattle" means horse, mare, gelding, colt, filly, mule, ass, bull, cow, ox, heifer, ram, ewe, sheep, lamb, camel, llama, alpaca, buffalo, goat or pig.".

3. Section 140 of the Principal Statute is amended by in-Stealing serting after the word "alpaca" the word "buffalo".
