An Ordinance to amend the *Criminal Law Consolidation Act and Ordinance 1876 to 1969* as amended

[Assented to 11 December, 1973]

**B**E it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Northern Territory of Australia as follows:

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Criminal Law Consolidation Ordinance (No. 3) 1973*. Short title

2. The *Criminal Law Consolidation Act and Ordinance 1876 to 1969* is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Statute. Principal Statute

3.(1) Section 16A(1)(b) of the Principal Statute is amended by omitting "death of" and substituting "death of, or grievous bodily harm to,". Causing death or bodily injury by negligent, &c., driving

(2) Section 16A of the Principal Statute is amended by inserting after sub-section (1) the following sub-section:

"(1A) On conviction of a person for an offence against this section, the Court may, in addition to any other penalty imposed on that person—

- (a) suspend any licence to drive a motor vehicle held by that person and disqualify him from holding such a licence for such period as the Court thinks fit; or
  - (b) if that person does not hold such a licence, disqualify him from holding such a licence for such period as the Court thinks fit."
