

CROWN LANDS ORDINANCE (No. 3) 1970

No. 79 of 1970

An Ordinance to amend the *Crown Lands Ordinance* 1931-1969 as amended by the *Crown Lands Ordinance* 1970 and the *Crown Lands Ordinance (No. 2) 1970*

[Reserved 11 December, 1970]

[Assented to 24 December, 1970]*

BE it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Northern Territory of Australia as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Crown Lands Ordinance (No. 3) 1970*. Short title and citation

(2.) The *Crown Lands Ordinance* 1931-1969 as amended by the *Crown Lands Ordinance* 1970 and the *Crown Lands Ordinance (No. 2) 1970* is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) Section 1 of the *Crown Lands Ordinance (No. 2) 1970* is amended by omitting sub-section (4.).

(4.) The Principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance may be cited as the *Crown Lands Ordinance* 1931-1970.

2. This Ordinance shall come into operation on a date to be fixed by the Administrator by notice in the *Gazette*.† Commencement

3. Section 37 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting from paragraph (c) the words "section thirty-nine A of this Ordinance" and inserting in their stead the words "section fourteen or section seventeen of the *Soil Conservation and Control Ordinance* 1969". Terms and conditions of pastoral leases

4. Section 39A and paragraph (d) of sub-section (1.) of section 40 of the Principal Ordinance are repealed. Repeal of section 39A, &c.

5. Where a pastoral lease that was granted before the commencement of this Ordinance contains a covenant by the lessee that, if a notice is served on him under section 39A, he will comply with the requirements of that notice, that covenant shall, upon the commencement of this Ordinance, cease to be binding. Stocking covenants no longer bind
