ENCOURAGEMENT OF PRIMARY PRODUCTION ORDINANCE 1968

No. 28 of 1968

An Ordinance to amend the *Encouragement of Primary* Production Ordinance 1931–1965

[Assented to 18 June, 1968]

BE it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Northern Territory of Australia, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Northern Territory (Administration) Act 1910-1968, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the Encouragement Short title and citation of Primary Production Ordinance 1968.

- (2.) The Encouragement of Primary Production Ordinance 1931-1965 is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.
- (3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the Encouragement of Primary Production Ordinance 1931-1968.
- 2. Section 3 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by insert- Definitions ing after the definition of "The Board" the following definition:—

- "the Gazette' means the Northern Territory Government Gazette:".
- 3. Section 34 of the Principal Ordinance is repealed and the following section is inserted in its stead:—
- "34. The Administrator in Council may make regulations, Regulations not inconsistent with this Ordinance, prescribing all matters required or permitted by this Ordinance to be prescribed, or necessary or convenient to be prescribed for carrying out or giving effect to this Ordinance.".

4. The regulations in force under the Principal Ordinance Savings immediately before the commencement of this Ordinance are as valid and effectual as if they had been made under the Principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance and shall, subject to any regulations made under the Principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance, continue in force notwithstanding the repeal effected by the last preceding section.
