

# HOLIDAYS ORDINANCE 1963.

## No. 29 of 1963.

### An Ordinance to amend the *Holidays Ordinance* 1957-1962.

[Assented to 23rd April, 1963.]

**B**E it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Northern Territory of Australia, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Northern Territory (Administration) Act* 1910-1962, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Holidays Ordinance* 1963. Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Holidays Ordinance* 1957-1962 is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Holidays Ordinance* 1957-1963.

2. Section four of the Principal Ordinance is amended by adding at the end thereof the following sub-sections:— Public and bank holidays.

“(6.) When the first day of May falls on a day other than a Monday, the next following Monday shall be observed as a public holiday and bank holiday instead of the first day of May.

“(7.) When the anniversary of the birthday of the Sovereign falls on a day other than the first Monday after the thirty-first day of May, that Monday shall be observed as a public holiday and bank holiday instead of the anniversary of the birthday of the Sovereign.”
