

HOLIDAYS ORDINANCE 1969

481

No. 30 of 1970

An Ordinance to amend the *Holidays Ordinance 1957-1967*

[Reserved 10 December, 1969]

[Assented to 13 July, 1970]*

BE it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Northern Territory of Australia as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Holidays Ordinance 1969*. Short title and citation

(2.) The *Holidays Ordinance 1957-1967* is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance may be cited as the *Holidays Ordinance 1957-1969*.

2. This Ordinance shall come into operation on a date to be fixed by the Administrator by notice in the *Gazette*.[†] Commencement

3. Section 6A of the Principal Ordinance is amended— Saturday banking

- (a) by omitting from sub-section (2.) the words “every Friday which is not a public holiday or half-holiday or a bank holiday or half-holiday” and inserting in their stead the words “the last working day preceding the Saturday in every week.”;
- (b) by adding at the end thereof the following sub-section:—

“(4.) In this section ‘working day’ means, in relation to the Territory or a part of the Territory, as the case requires, a day that is not a Sunday and is not—

- (a) a day that is required by or under this Ordinance to be observed as a public holiday and bank holiday or as a bank holiday; or
- (b) a day of which the afternoon is required by or under this Ordinance to be observed as a public half-holiday and bank half-holiday or as a bank half-holiday.”.

4. A notice published under section 6A of the Principal Ordinance before the commencement of this Ordinance has no effect in relation to a Saturday that occurs after the commencement of this Ordinance. Existing notices
