

HOLIDAYS ORDINANCE 1973

1413

No. 3 of 1973

An Ordinance to amend the *Holidays Ordinance 1957* as amended

[Assented to 13 March, 1973]

BE it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Northern Territory of Australia as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Holidays Ordinance* 1973. Short title
2. The *Holidays Ordinance 1957* as amended is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance. Principal Ordinance
3. Section 4 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting sub-sections (2.), (3.), (4.), (5.) and (6.). Public and bank holidays
4. Section 4A of the Principal Ordinance is repealed. Repeal of section 4A
5. Section 6 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting the words “not less than twenty-eight days before the day to which the declaration applies”. Public holidays and bank holidays may be altered
6. The Schedule to the Principal Ordinance is repealed and the following Schedule inserted in its stead:— The Schedule

“THE SCHEDULE

The first day of January (New Year's Day), or, if that day falls on a Saturday or Sunday, the following Monday
The twenty-sixth day of January (Australia Day), or, if that day does not fall on a Monday, the following Monday
Good Friday
The Saturday following Good Friday
The Monday following Good Friday
The twenty-fifth day of April (Anzac Day) or, if that day falls on a Sunday, the following Monday
The first Monday in May (May Day)
Christmas Day, or, if that day falls on a Saturday or Sunday, the following Monday
The twenty-sixth day of December (Boxing Day), or, if that day falls on a Saturday, the following Monday, or, if the twenty-sixth day of December falls on a Sunday or Monday, the following Tuesday
The day fixed by the Sovereign to be the day for the observance of the anniversary of the birthday of the Sovereign, or, if that day does not fall on a Monday, the following Monday”.
