An Ordinance to amend the Interpretation Ordinance 1931–1959 and for other purposes.

[Assented to 18th June, 1962.]

B^E it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Northern Territory of Australia, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Northern Territory (Administration) Act 1910-1961, as follows:----

1.-(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the Interpretation short title and citation. Ordinance 1962.

(2.) The Interpretation Ordinance 1931-1959 is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the Interpretation Ordinance 1931-1962.

2. Section sixteen of the Principal Ordinance is amended Regulations by omitting from paragraph (a) of sub-section (1.) the words made by Minister. "Commonwealth of Australia Gazette" and inserting in their stead the words "Gazette of the Northern Territory".

3. Where, before the commencement of this Ordinance, validation regulations made by a Minister were published in the Gazette regulations. of the Northern Territory or a notice of the regulations having been made was published in that Gazette, those regulations, by force of this section—

- (a) have the same force and effect as if section sixteen of the Interpretation Ordinance 1931 or of that Ordinance as amended from time to time had been complied with: and
- (b) shall be deemed to have had that force and effect from the date of the publication of the regulations or of the notice or, if a later date was specified in the regulations, from that later date.
