

LOTTERY AND GAMING ORDINANCE 1971

713

No. 7 of 1971

An Ordinance to amend the *Lottery and
Gaming Ordinance 1940-1970*

[Assented to 24 March, 1971]

BE it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Northern Territory of Australia as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Lottery and Gaming Ordinance 1971*. Short title and citation

(2.) The *Lottery and Gaming Ordinance 1940-1970* is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance may be cited as the *Lottery and Gaming Ordinance 1940-1971*.

2. Section 94ADA of the Principal Ordinance is amended by adding at the end thereof the following sub-sections:— Times during which licensed premises may be open for betting or shall be closed

“(2.) Where the Board receives a request from a registered racing club that premises within fifty miles of a licensed racecourse on which it is to conduct a race meeting be closed after one o'clock in the afternoon on the day of the race meeting, it shall, provided that it receives the request not less than one month before the date of the race meeting and provided that the effect of complying with the request would not be that premises would be closed in respect of more than twenty-five days in any one year, so prescribe the hours within which those premises may be open on that day as to comply with the request.

“(3.) Where the Board receives a request from the proprietor of a licensed dog-racing ground that premises within fifty miles of that dog-racing ground be closed after six o'clock in the evening on a day on which a dog-racing meeting is to be conducted on that dog-racing ground, it shall, provided that it receives the request not less than one month before the date of the dog-racing meeting and provided that the effect of complying with the request would not be that premises

would be closed in respect of more than twenty-five days in any one year, so prescribe the hours within which those premises may be open on that day as to comply with the request.”.

Transitional

3. In respect of the period from the date of commencement of this Ordinance until the thirty-first day of December, 1971 the amendments effected by the last preceding section apply as though the reference (wherever occurring) to twenty-five days in any one year were a reference to eighteen days in the period from the date of commencement of this Ordinance until the thirty-first day of December, 1971.
