

LOTTERY AND GAMING ORDINANCE (No. 5) 1972

No. 72 of 1972

An Ordinance to amend the *Lottery and Gaming Ordinance* 1940 as amended

[Assented to 5 December, 1972]

BE it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Northern Territory of Australia as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Lottery and Gaming Ordinance (No. 5) 1972*. Short title

2. The *Lottery and Gaming Ordinance* 1940 as amended is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance. Principal Ordinance

3. Section 81 of the Principal Ordinance is amended— Conditions of use of totalizator

(a) by inserting after paragraph (a) the following paragraph:—

“(aa) used in accordance with any rules approved under sub-section (2.);” and

(b) by adding at the end thereof the following sub-sections:—

“(2.) The Administrator in Council may approve rules subject to which a totalizator may be conducted.

“(3.) Rules approved under sub-section (2.) shall be notified in the *Gazette* by a notice stating that the rules have been approved and specifying the place where copies of the rules can be purchased or obtained.

“(4.) Rules so approved shall come into operation on the date of the notification in the *Gazette*.

“(5.) The Administrator shall, on the first sitting day of the Legislative Council after any rules have been so approved by the Administrator in Council, cause the rules to be laid before the Legislative Council.

“(6.) If the Legislative Council in pursuance of a motion of which notice has been given within fifteen sittings days after any rules have been laid before the Legislative Council passes a resolution disallowing any of those rules, the disallowed rule shall thereupon cease to have effect.

“(7.) If a disallowed rule amended or repealed a rule in force immediately before the commencement of the disallowed rule, the disallowance revives the previous rule as if the disallowed rule had not been made.

“(8.) Rules approved under sub-section (2.) shall not be regarded as regulations for the purposes of the *Regulations Publication Ordinance*.”.

Regulations

4. Section 99 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting paragraphs (c) and (e).
