**LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY
(REMUNERATION OF MEMBERS)
ORDINANCE 1978**

No. 65 of 1978

An Ordinance relating to the remuneration payable to
members of the Legislative Assembly

[Assented to 5 July 1978]

BE it ordained by the Legislative Assembly for the Northern Territory of Australia as follows:

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Legislative Assembly (Remuneration of Members) Ordinance 1978*. Short title

2. In this Ordinance, unless the contrary intention appears— Definitions

“member” means a member of the Legislative Assembly;

“remuneration” means salary, allowances or salary and allowances to be paid to a member by reason of his membership of the Legislative Assembly, or by reason of his holding a particular office or offices, or performing a particular function or functions in, or in relation to, the Legislative Assembly;

“Tribunal” means the Remuneration Tribunal established by section 4(1) of the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973* of the Commonwealth.

3. Subject to this Ordinance, the Executive Council may, from time to time, determine the remuneration to be paid to members. Executive Council to determine remuneration of members

4. (1) The Executive Council may, at its discretion, by notice in writing given to the Tribunal, request that the Tribunal inquire into and determine, from time to time, the remuneration to be paid to members. Executive Council may request Tribunal to determine remuneration

(2) A request made pursuant to sub-section (1) may be rescinded by the Executive Council by notice in writing given to the Tribunal.

(3) Where a request pursuant to sub-section (1) has been made, the Executive Council shall not determine the remuneration to be paid to members unless it first rescinds that request in accordance with sub-section (2).

5. A determination of the remuneration to be paid to members shall come into operation, or shall be deemed to have come into operation, on such date as is specified in that determination.

6. The Minister shall, as soon as practicable after a determination of the remuneration to be paid to members is received by him, cause a copy of that determination to be laid before the Legislative Assembly.
