## LOCAL GOVERNMENT ORDINANCE (No. 4) 1972

## No. 66 of 1972

An Ordinance to permit Local Government By-laws to be made in relation to Private Swimming Pools

[Assented to 5 December, 1972]

B<sup>E</sup> it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Northern Territory of Australia as follows:—

- 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Local Government Short title Ordinance (No. 4) 1972.
- 2. The Local Government Ordinance 1954 as amended is Principal in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.
  - 3. Section 349 of the Principal Ordinance is amended— By-laws
    - (a) by inserting in sub-paragraph (y) of paragraph (28), after the word "fencing", the words ", including fences and fencing around a swimming pool installed or to be installed on the land on which the building is or is to be erected"; and
    - (b) by inserting after paragraph (50) the following paragraph:—
      - "(50A) requiring and regulating the fencing of swimming pools installed on private land or premises;".
