## LOCAL GOVERNMENT ORDINANCE (No. 4) 1973

## No. 64 of 1973

## An Ordinance to amend the *Local Government* Ordinance 1954 as amended

[Assented to 11 December, 1973]

BE it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Northern

Territory of Australia as follows:— Territory of Australia as follows:-

- 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Local Government Short title *Ordinance* (No. 4) 1973.
- 2. The Local Government Ordinance 1954 as amended is Principal in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.
- 3. Section 3 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omit-Parts ting--

"Division 3A—Allowances to Members of Council (Section 44A).

and substituting-

"Division 3A—Allowances and Fees to Members of Council (Sections 44A-44B)".

4. The heading to Division 3A of Part IV of the Principal Heading to Ordinance is repealed and the following heading substituted:

Division 3A of Part IV

"Division 3A—Allowances and Fees to Members of Council".

5. Section 44A of the Principal Ordinance is amended by Travelling allowance inserting after sub-section (2) the following sub-section:

"(2A) The council of a municipality may pay to or on behalf of a member representing the council on an association of local government councils of the Northern Territory of which the council is a member a reasonable allowance towards his necessary out-of-pocket expenses for conveyance and subsistence in travelling to and from a meeting of such an association.".

- **6.** After section 44A of the Principal Ordinance the following section is inserted:
- "44B.(1) A council may pay to a member of the council a fee for—
  - (a) attending a meeting of—
    - (i) the council; or
    - (ii) a committee of the council;
  - (b) an inspection within the municipality undertaken by the member in compliance with a resolution of the council; or
  - (c) attendance upon business of the council outside the municipality in compliance with a resolution of the council.
- "(2) Subject to sub-sections (3) and (4), the amount of the fee payable in respect of a matter under this section shall be fixed by a resolution of the council.
- "(3) The amount of the fee payable in respect of a matter under this section shall not exceed—
  - (a) in the case of the mayor or chairman of a committee of the council—25 dollars per day;
  - (b) in the case of an alderman other than the chairman of a committee of the council—20 dollars per day; and
  - (c) in the aggregate in a financial year—1,000 dollars.
- "(4) A fee is not payable under this section to a member in respect of more than one matter on the same day.".

Purposes for which revenue may be expended

- 7. Section 210 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by inserting, after paragraph (g), the following paragraph:
  - "(ga) in making yearly subscriptions and other payments to an association of local government councils of the Northern Territory of which the council is a member;".
