## An Ordinance to amend the Legal Practitioners Ordinance 1965

[Assented to 3 December, 1970]

BE it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Northern Territory of Australia as follows: Territory of Australia as follows:-

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the Legal Prac- short title titioners Ordinance 1970.

- (2.) The Legal Practitioners Ordinance 1965 is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.
- (3.) The Principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance may be cited as the Legal Practitioners Ordinance 1965-1970.
- 2. Section 3 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by Qualifications omitting paragraph (c) of sub-section (2.) and inserting in its appractitioner stead the following paragraphs:—

- "(c) the service under the articles shall be for a period of at least-
  - (i) in the case of a person who has had not less than one year's experience as an associate to a Judge in the two years immediately preceding the date on which he commences to serve under the articles—one year;
  - (ii) in the case of a person who has had less than one year's experience as an associate to a Judge in the two years immediately preceding the date on which he commences to serve under the articles—two years less the period of his experience as an associate to a Judge in the two years immediately preceding the date on which he commences to serve under the articles;

- (iii) in any other case—two years; and
- (d) at least one year of the articles shall be served after the person serving under them has qualified for admission to a degree as a graduate in law.".
