

LONG SERVICE LEAVE ORDINANCE 1970

An Ordinance to amend the *Long Service Leave Ordinance 1965*

[Assented to 13 May, 1970]

BE it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Northern Territory of Australia as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Long Service Leave Ordinance 1970*. Short title and citation

(2.) The *Long Service Leave Ordinance 1965* is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance may be cited as the *Long Service Leave Ordinance 1965-1970*.

2. After section 17 of the Principal Ordinance the following section is inserted:—

“17A.—(1.) A worker shall not, during any period when he is on long service leave pursuant to this Ordinance, engage in his usual vocation for remuneration. Engaging in employment during long service leave

“(2.) A person shall not employ a worker for remuneration in the worker's usual vocation during any period when, to the person's knowledge, the worker is on long service leave pursuant to this Ordinance.”
