## NATIVE CONSTABULARY ORDINANCE 1940 REPEAL ORDINANCE 1964.

## No. 27 of 1964.

An Ordinance to repeal the Native Constabulary Ordinance 1940.

[Assented to 14th July, 1964.]\*

BE it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Northern Territory of Australia, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Northern Territory (Administration) Act 1910-1962, as follows:—

- 1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Native Constabulary Short title. Ordinance 1940 Repeal Ordinance 1964.
  - 2 The Native Constabulary Ordinance 1940 is repealed. Repeal.
