POLICE AND POLICE OFFENCES ORDINANCE 1971

No. 9 of 1971

An Ordinance to amend the Police and Police Offences Ordinance 1923-1970

[Assented to 24 March, 1971]

B^E it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Northern Territory of Australia as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the Police and Short title and citation 'olice Offences Ordinance 1971.

- (2.) The Police and Police Offences Ordinance 1923-1970 s in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.
- (3.) The Principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance nay be cited as the Police and Police Offences Ordinance 1923-971.
- 2. The Principal Ordinance is amended by inserting after Tampering with instruments &c. ection 65 the following new section:—

- "65a.—(1.) Any person who—
 - (a) with intent to deceive tampers with any instrument or device used for the recording of mileage in a motor vehicle; or
 - (b) with intent to deceive installs in substitution for an instrument or device used in a motor vehicle for recording the mileage of the motor vehicle a new instrument or device for recording the mileage of the motor vehicle-

shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a penalty of not more han \$100.".
