

## PUBLIC HEALTH ORDINANCE 1962.

## No. 14 of 1962.

An Ordinance to amend the *Public Health Ordinance* 1952-1961.

[Assented to 8th June, 1962.]

**B**E it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Northern Territory of Australia, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Northern Territory (Administration) Act* 1910-1961, as follows:—

Short title and citation.

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Public Health Ordinance* 1962.

(2.) The *Public Health Ordinance* 1952-1961 is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Public Health Ordinance* 1952-1962.

Commencement.

2. This Ordinance shall come into operation on a date to be fixed by the Administrator by notice in the *Gazette*.\*

3. Section seven of the Principal Ordinance is repealed and the following section inserted in its stead:—

Powers of Chief Medical Officer and Medical Officer of Health.

“7.—(1.) The Chief Medical Officer shall, in addition to the powers conferred on him by this Ordinance or by the Regulations, have the powers conferred by this Ordinance or by the Regulations on a Medical Officer of Health.

“(2.) The Chief Medical Officer and each Medical Officer of Health shall, in addition to the powers conferred on them by this Ordinance or by the Regulations, have the powers conferred by this Ordinance or by the Regulations on an Inspector.”.
