

PHARMACY ORDINANCE 1969

No. 3 of 1969

An Ordinance to amend the *Pharmacy Ordinance* 1936-1964

[Reserved 25 September, 1968]

[Assented to 21 February, 1969]*

BE it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Northern Territory of Australia, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Northern Territory (Administration) Act* 1910-1968, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Pharmacy Ordinance* 1968. Short title and citation

(2.) The *Pharmacy Ordinance* 1936-1964 is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Pharmacy Ordinance* 1936-1968.

2. This Ordinance shall come into operation on a date to be fixed by the Administrator in Council.† Commencement

3. Section 7 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting from sub-section (1.) the words “(c) three registered pharmacists.” and inserting in their stead the words “(c) four registered pharmacists, not more than three of whom may be residents of the Darwin Town Area as described in the Schedule to the *Darwin Lands Acquisition Act* 1945.” Appointment of Members
