An Ordinance to amend the *Stock Diseases Ordinance* 1954-1961.

[Assented to 25th October, 1962.]

BE it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Northern Territory of Australia, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Northern Territory (Administration) Act* 1910-1961, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Stock Diseases Ordinance* 1962. Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Stock Diseases Ordinance* 1954-1961 is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Stock Diseases Ordinance* 1954-1962.

2. Section three of the Principal Ordinance is amended by Parta. omitting the words—

“ Part IV.—Importation of Stock into Northern Territory.”

and inserting in their stead the words—

“ Part IV.—Importation of Stock and Products of Stock into Northern Territory.”.

3. The heading to Part IV. of the Principal Ordinance is amended by inserting after the word “ STOCK ” the words “ AND PRODUCTS OF STOCK ”. Heading to Part IV.

4. Section twenty-three of the Principal Ordinance is amended— Prohibition against or restriction of importation of stock, &c.

(a) by omitting all the words after the word “ Territory ” (second occurring) and inserting in their stead the words “, from that area or place, of stock, or of stock of a particular species or class, or of meat or any other product obtained from stock or from stock of a particular species or class.”; and

(b) by adding at the end thereof the following sub-section:—

“(2.) A person shall not import into the Territory stock or meat or any other product of stock in contravention of a prohibition or restriction notified under the last preceding sub-section.

Penalty: Two hundred pounds.”.

5. Section forty-two of the Principal Ordinance is amended—

(a) by omitting from paragraph (i) of sub-section (1.) the word “and” (second occurring); and

(b) by adding at the end of sub-section (1.) the following word and paragraph:—

“; and (v) seize and destroy any stock or any meat or other product of stock that has entered or been imported into the Territory in contravention of section twenty-three of this Ordinance.”.
