An Ordinance to amend the *Stock Diseases Ordinance* 1954-1962.

[Assented to 9th September, 1963.]

**B**E it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Northern Territory of Australia, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Northern Territory (Administration) Act* 1910-1962, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Stock Diseases Ordinance* 1963. Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Stock Diseases Ordinance* 1954-1962 is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Stock Diseases Ordinance* 1954-1963.

2. After section forty-one of the Principal Ordinance the following section is inserted:—

“ 41A. The Chief Inspector may, by notice in the *Gazette*— Chief Inspector may prohibit use of drugs, &c.

(a) prohibit a drug specified in the notice, or a substance containing such a drug or more than a specified proportion of such a drug, from being used in the treatment of stock; or

(b) prohibit such a drug or such a substance from being so used under such circumstances or subject to such conditions as are specified in the notice.”
