## STOCK DISEASES ORDINANCE 1963.

## No. 66 of 1963.

An Ordinance to amend the Stock Diseases Ordinance 1954-1962.

[Assented to 9th September, 1963.]

B<sup>E</sup> it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Northern Territory of Australia, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Northern Territory (Administration) Act 1910-1962, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the Stock Diseases Short title Ordinance 1963.

- (2.) The Stock Diseases Ordinance 1954-1962 is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.
- (3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the Stock Diseases Ordinance 1954-1963.
- 2. After section forty-one of the Principal Ordinance the following section is inserted:—
  - "41A. The Chief Inspector may, by notice in the Gazette— chief Inspector may prohibit use of drugs,
    - (a) prohibit a drug specified in the notice, or a substance containing such a drug or more than a specified proportion of such a drug, from being used in the treatment of stock: or
    - (b) prohibit such a drug or such a substance from being so used under such circumstances or subject to such conditions as are specified in the notice.".
